Camilla Connolly is a painter based in Murwillumbah, NSW.

She grew up in Sydney and attended the Buttery Therapeutic Community ten years ago. She returned to painting 6 years ago after a long break. Since her return to her art practice she has been selected for such competitions as The Portia Geach Memorial Award, The Paddington Art Prize, The Country Energy Landscape Prize and the Waverley Art Prize.

Connolly is currently painting a series of generic portraits based on her life, titled "High Art Low Life."

Her portrait of Mungo MacCallum was selected for the National Portrait Gallery's online exhibition in 2007. Connolly also paints landscapes.

She is represented by Schubert Contemporary on the Gold Coast.
