Since living in Byron Bay, Tiffany has been exploring the relationship of nature in primitive cultures in her art.

Her latest series of work is devoted to the wetlands existing amongst suburban development in Byron Bay. Her work specifically examines the different ideals between cultures that worship, and those that neglect, elements of nature.
